- Potential to contribute to broader social impact and further gender equity
- Interdisciplinary work

• **Proposal Narrative** (max 700 words) Describe your project, and the work to be carried out in summer 2020. Describe how these activities relate to gender equity. Share how your personal background and identity relate to your research proposal.
