East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) invites candidates who have the appropriate qualifications to apply for this intern position (**part-time - 19 hours per week, when school is in session OR temporary full time - 40 hours per week for up to 6 months on school breaks**) in the Water Distribution Planning Division (WDPD) of the Engineering and Construction Department. WDPD mainly focuses on determining the size of pipelines, pumping plants and water storage tanks necessary to supply customers and provide fire flows within the water distribution system. The work group is currently primarily telecommuting and coming into the office for essential items only. When conditions improve the work group will return to the office.

The Engineering Aide will assist engineers in the section by performing the following typical tasks:

- Developing new hydraulic models and analyzing data to determine water usage over the day.
- Hydraulic modeling to determine available flow and pressure within the water distribution system.
- Reviewing plans submitted by developers to determine water infrastructure needs.
- Reviewing environmental impact reports written by

other public agencies, evaluating the project impacts to EBMUD and writing comment letters addressing those impacts.

- Writing Notice of Exemptions to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act.
- Conducting hydrant flow tests to determine available flow and pressure and to measure head loss between points within the water distribution system.
- Analyzing impacts to the water distribution system by temporarily/permanently removing pipelines and/or water storage tanks from service.

1. **Junior, Senior, or Graduate** engineering student currently enrolled at an accredited college or university with interest in civil and/or environmental engineering.
2. Valid California driver's license and satisfactory driving record.
3. US citizen or have proof of the legal right to remain and work in the United States.
