They are hosting a virtual career fair **October 29 from 3-5 pm PST**, where students can chat live with Arup employees about our roles and culture.

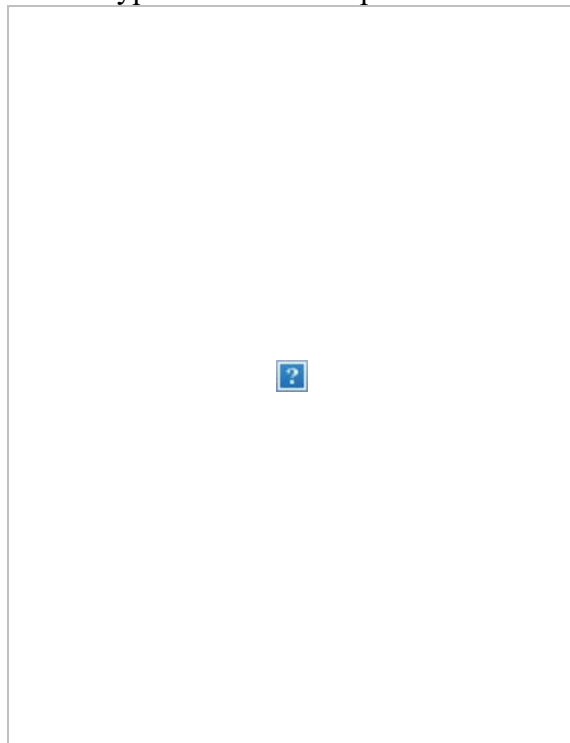
